



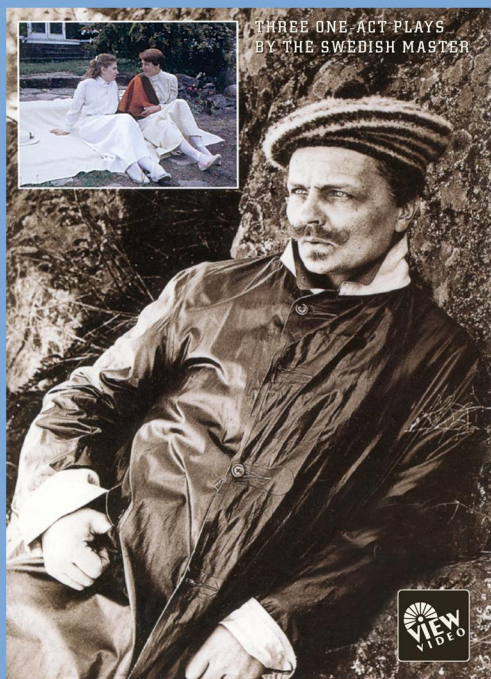

### ABOUT AUGUST STRINDBERG

Johan August Strindberg (1849-1912) wrote prolifically over 4 decades as a novelist, essayist, and playwright. A rebellious visionary, Strindberg's work varied drastically in subject matter, dramatic technique, and form. His meticulous and controlled writing was so purposefully detailed that it was believed to be too difficult to stage correctly until the advent of motion pictures.

Early works such as *The Red Room*, which is remembered as the first modern Swedish novel and considered part of the Naturalistic movement, propelled him to notoriety. Strindberg continued to enhance his reputation as a revolutionary with works that retrospectively are obvious artistic ancestors to both Expressionism and Surrealism.



Strindberg created a thought-provoking and stirring collection of essays, plays, fiction, autobiography, historical fiction, cultural and political analysis, and artistic critiques. A cited influence to future writers such as Ingmar Bergman, John Osborne, and Tennessee Williams, August Strindberg is considered a pioneer of modern European theater and staging, as well as the father of modern Swedish literature.
